








**Lesson Objective #1:** Describe the main function of the nervous system.






**Lesson Objective #1:** Describe the main function of the nervous system. (p. 1)

The **nervous system** sends messages back and forth between the **brain** and other parts of the body. It controls the ability to move, breathe, see, think, and feel.





















**Lesson Objective #2:** Identify the main parts of the nervous system and describe their functions. (p. 1)

- **Brain:** An **organ**; the control center of the body that sends and receives signals to and from the body
- Spinal Cord: A long bundle of nerves; like a superhighway that carries messages between the brain and the rest of the body
- **Nerves:** A bundle of nerve fibers; send messages to and from the brain

































#### THE SPINAL CORD

The **spinal cord** connects the **brain** to the body, helps you move, and carries messages throughout the body.




















#### THE NERVES

Nerves carry messages back and forth between the brain and other parts of the body.





























The **cerebrum** controls thinking, learning, and feeling emotions; it also controls your **voluntary muscles**, the ones that move when you want them to.






























#### THE CEREBELLUM












#### THE BRAIN STEM

The **brain stem** controls **involuntary muscle functions** (**muscles** you don't control) like breathing and heart rate.




















